

Lesson plan

1. Match the cutups and check your answer together.
2. Practise in pairs. Write the vocabulary on worksheet.
3. Peer correction
4. Complete question forming worksheet
5. Write your answers on the board
6. Drill the questions with headings only
7. Ask them to use cut ups to practise the weather
8. Write degrees on the board (7, 28, -3,) Hand out table of degrees and ask them to practise talking about the weather in the different countries.
9. For the text about seasons, you could ask them to in groups of 3-4 to draw every sentence on A3 paper and feedback to the class or you could dictate part of the text to them. Another possibility is that they dictate the text to each other.

Spitting - raining a little.












