### Pronouns

Pronouns are used to replace **nouns** in a sentence.

Pronouns are put in front of a verb.

There are 2 types of pronouns: **Subject and object**

Subject pronoun is used with who/what is doing the action.

Object pronoun is used with who/what is receiving the action.

Example 1

Sam drives the car.

He drives the car.

**Sam** is doing the action – driving the car.

Sam is the subject.

We can replace Sam with the pronoun '**he**'.

Example 2

Nina gives the boy an apple.

She gives him the apple.

**Nina** is doing the action – giving the apple.

Nina is the subject.

We can replace Nina with pronoun '**she**'.

**The boy** is receiving the action – getting the apple.

The boy is the object.

We can replace the boy with the pronoun '**him**'.
